TECHNICAL DISRUPTION OF REMOTE PARTICIPATION -
BOARD MEETING POLICY**

To comply with recent legislative amendments enacted by Senate Bill 707, this policy establishes the procedure to be followed in the event of a disruption in two-way remote participation (including, but not limited to, Zoom) during an Board or Executive Committee meeting. In the event of such disruption, if the disruption prevents members of the public from remotely attending or observing the meeting, the Agency Board or Executive Committee shall recess for no less than one hour, during which time staff shall make good faith efforts to restore service. Following such efforts, the AGENCY Board or Executive Committee shall adopt, by roll-call vote, a formal finding affirming that reasonable efforts were made to resolve the disruption and that resuming the meeting serves the public interest more than further delaying the meeting to seek a resolution.
